

Our TTC Journey Week 25 – May 2nd – May 8th, 2008

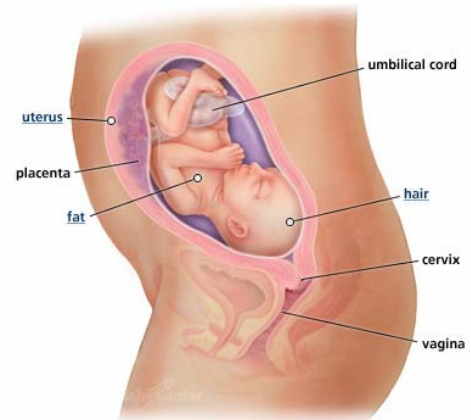


We finally have a decision on the baby's name !!! [James Alexander](#) is on his way !!
