

Our TTC Journey Week 6 – December 21-27, 2007

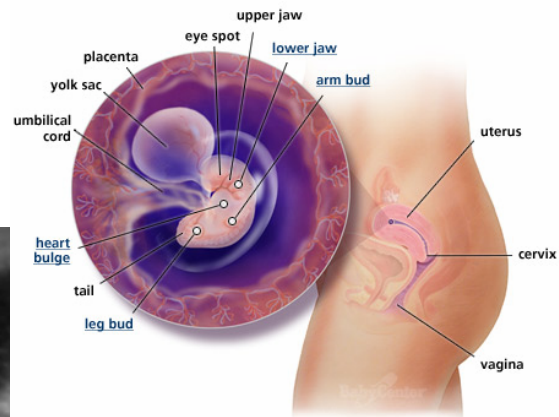


Overall I'm finding that I've to use the restroom more often than normal. I also am eating more veggies than I was, and am finding that I actually like them.

So far at work, Mark, Pat, Kris, Stracy, Heath, Eric, Cheri, Darrell, Laura, Monica and Loli know that I'm expecting. I'm trying to keep it from as many people as possible. I've also not told my family in Willits.

I have also told Misty, Celia, Kerry, Kamili, Jenn W, and the Lunitik Gals. They are all very excited to hear the news.

This week's major developments: The nose, mouth, and ears that you'll spend so much time kissing in eight months are beginning to take shape. If you could see into your uterus, you'd find an oversize head and dark spots where your baby's eyes and nostrils are starting to form. His emerging ears are marked by small depressions on the sides of the head, and his arms and legs by protruding buds.



His heart is beating about 100 to 160 times a minute — almost twice as fast as yours — and blood is beginning to course through his body. (124 bpm!)

His intestines are developing, and the bud of tissue that will give rise to his lungs has appeared. His pituitary gland is forming, as are the rest of his brain, muscles, and bones. Right now, your baby is a quarter of an inch long, about the size of a lentil bean.

December 23rd – Vishu and Ram came to visit today and brought Syna with them. She really is very cute. I took a great picture with her. I felt good, a little tired, and I rested some. I got a little nauseous, but it was at night. I also seem to still have a few mild cramps per day.



December 24th – I've had a bloated feeling for a few weeks now. It constantly feels like I need to just burp. Or if a pin is stuck into me, I'll go zigzagging around the room.

December 25th – I felt a little nauseous today. I was at first in a lounge around mood cause I didn't want to deal with people. I showered and changed, and then went to Celia's for Christmas. I felt a little nauseous, but the food tasted good. So I was glad I went. It is finding the motivation to get up, that's the hard part. I get very tired at night.

December 26th – In the middle of the night last night I woke up at 5am starving and nauseous, and I ate a few crackers and went back to sleep. I didn't feel like doing anything to myself when I woke up. I barely felt like getting up. I felt a little nauseous today. It was accompanied with mild IBS. I've never noticed that my fingernails are as long as they are now! I almost don't need acrylics anymore!

December 27th – I went to the doctor's office today, and in the ultrasound we were able to see a heartbeat! My uterine lining looked perfect, Beanlette measured perfect, and all looked just perfect! I start my 7th week tomorrow and couldn't be happier!
